Assessment Session Lengths

FSA ELA Retake

The FSA ELA Writing **Retake** is administered in one 120-minute test session.

The FSA ELA Reading **Retake** is administered in two 90-minute test sessions over two days.

For the FSA ELA Writing Retake and ELA Reading Retake assessments, **any student** who has not completed a session by the end of the allotted time **may continue working**; however, **each session may last no longer than half the length of a typical school day.**

FSA ELA

The FSA Grade 9 & 10 ELA Writing is administered in one 120-minute test session.

The FSA Grade 9 & 10 ELA Reading is administered in two 90-minute test sessions over two days.

For FSA ELA Writing and Reading assessments there is no extra time, each session lasts as stated above.

FSA EOC Assessments

The FSA Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC assessments are administered in two 90-minute test sessions over two days. Any student who has not completed a session by the end of the allotted time may continue working; however, each session may last **no longer than half the length of a typical school day.**

NGSSS EOC Assessments

The FSA Biology and U.S. History EOC assessments are administered in one 160-minute test session. Any student who has not completed a session by the end of the allotted time may continue working; however, **testing may last no longer than the length of a typical school day.**

AP Exams are approximately 2.5 – 3.5 hours in length; each exam is unique.
